Foreword

1 Scope

This International Standard specifies the essential dimensional characteristics of hexagon nuts with a flat seat captive washer for 18, 20 and 22 mm studs.

2 Field of application

This International Standard applies to nuts designed for fixing flat attachment wheels with centring on central bore the dimensional characteristics of which are covered in ISO 4107.

Only the dimensions necessary to ensure interchangeability are specified. The nut technology, and particularly the design of the nut relative to the washer, is left to the manufacturer.
